Approval of Agenda

New Business

- a. Re-Canvass of 2020 General Election
 - Removal of Ineligible Votes
 - Mr. Bowens presented the Board with a summary of ineligible votes. Following review, Ms. Baxton moved to reject one provisional ballot and 5 Absentee-by-Mail ballots had been previously approved consistent with State Board guidance on double voters/ineligible voters. The motion passed by all, 5-0.
 - Ms. Baxton also moved to reject one provisional ballot that was approved in error due to a twin mix-up. The motion passed by all, 5-0.
 - Review of Timely Absentee-by-Mail Ballot
 - Mr. Bowens presented the Board with one timely Absentee-by-Mail cure certification. Following review, Ms. Baxton moved to accept the application and ballot. The motion passed by all, 5-0.
 - Review of Timely Provisional Ballot Cure
 - Mr. Bowens presented the Board with one timely provisional cure. Following review, Ms. Baxton moved to accept the cured provisional application and ballot. The motion passed by all, 5-0.
 - The Board executed all required documentation prior to reviewing the consolidated results for re-certification. After the review of re-canvass documents, Chairman Lehman moved to approve the re-certification of the November 3, 2020 General Election. The motion was approved by all, 5-0.
