## **Meeting Opening**

Chairwoman Baxton called the meeting to order at approximately 5:20 p.m. at the Board of Elections Warehouse (2445 S. Alston Ave, Durham, NC 27713) and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

# **Approval of Agenda**

Mr. Bowens presented the Board with the agenda for the meeting. Following review, Mr. Lehman moved to approve the agenda as submitted by staff. The motion carried unanimously, 4-0. Mr. Irby was not present for this meeting.

#### **Approval of Minutes**

Mr. Bowens presented the Board with minutes from the 10/4, 10/11, 10/18, 10/25, 11/01, 11/07, 11/08, 11/14, 11/15, 11/17, 11/18, and 1/18 meetings. Following review, Mr. Lehman moved to approve the minutes as submitted by staff. The motion carried unanimously, 4-0.

#### **New Business**

# a. Approval of FY 2023-2024 Budget

• Mr. Bowens presented the Board with a request to accept the FY23-24 budget. The budget will cover July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024, which includes the 2023 Municipal Elections and 2024 Statewide Primary Election. The total requested budget, not including Budget Department additions, is \$3,587,944.00. This budget does not include funding for a potential second primary consistent with a request from county administration as they will provide funding if the election is necessary. Following discussion and review, Mr. Lehman moved to accept the FY23-24 budget. The motion passed unanimously, 4-0.

# **General Discussion**

Mr. Bowens provided updates on an upcoming U.S. Senate Hearing with the Rules and Administration Committee, a presentation by staff at the NCADE Conference, and a meeting with the Committee for Safe and Secure Elections in Arizona.
