Mrs. Oxendine authorized staff to perform all preparatory steps prior to the count on Election Day as outlined in the 'Delegation of Preparatory Work' section of Numbered Memo 2020-25 for this meeting and all future meetings of the Durham County Board of Elections. The motion carried unanimously, 5-0. The total approved count for the September 19, 2023, meeting was 18.
